<p><b>Indoor sporting event (not boxing or wrestling)</b></p>	<p><b>Health care providers, local authorities and school proprietors</b></p> <p>The provision of <u>any</u> entertainment by or on behalf of a health care provider, local authority or school proprietor is not to be regarded as the provision of regulated if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• provided on any premises forming part of a hospital, owned/occupied by LA or on school premises;</li><li>• not a domestic property;</li><li>• it takes place between 8am and 11pm;</li><li>• it is not relevant entertainment (SEV).</li></ul> <p><a href="#">(Article 3 of The Legislative Reform (Entertainment Licensing) Order 2014)</a></p>

## Health care providers, local authorities, school proprietors and community premises

The provision of any entertainment by or on behalf of a health care provider, local authority or school proprietor is not to be regarded as the provision of regulated if:

- provided on any premises forming part of a hospital, owned/occupied by LA or on school premises;
- not a domestic property;
- it takes place between 8am and 11pm;
- it is not relevant entertainment (SEV);
- organiser gets consent from person responsible for premises;
- it takes place in the presence of an audience of no more than 500 (applies to community premises only).

Otherwise deregulated if:

- it takes place between 8am and 11pm;
- it takes place at a licensed premises (*i.e. on sales*) or workplace (*i.e. not licensed or only for LNR and a workplace defined in regulation 2(1) of the Workplace (Health, Safety and*

## Health care providers, local authorities and school proprietors

The provision of any entertainment by or on behalf of a health care provider, local authority or school proprietor is not to be regarded as the provision of regulated if:

- provided on any premises forming part of a hospital, owned/occupied by LA or on school premises;
- not a domestic property;
- it takes place between 8am and 11pm;
- it is not relevant entertainment (SEV).
